The fellowship award consists of the basic stipend, plus allowance for dependants where applicable, plus Euro 100 per month. The Euro 100 per month is intended as a contribution towards welfare costs, such as a pension, health insurance or other related costs. However, the awardees take responsibility for use of this sum and their welfare; in line with FEBS policy, FEBS does not recognise recipients of its fellowships as agents or employees.

FEBS will normally reimburse the cost of travel of the fellow (and dependants) to the host institute; economy class travel will be reimbursed on presentation of invoices and receipts. N.B. Travel costs will not be paid if the applicant is already working at the host institute (applicable to Long-Term Fellowships only) at the closing date of the call.
