Eligibility of Principal Investigator and Team Members:

The Principal Investigator (PI) and all members of the research group must belong to the eligible institution or be affiliated to CIBER, CIBERNED or an IIS.

Excluded personnel as Principal Investigator (PI):

- Those undergoing a postgraduate training in Health Specialization (MIR, FIR, QIR, BIR, PIR)
- Those undergoing research training (e.g. PhD students, or "Río Hortega" contracts)
- Researchers contracted by a RETIC or a CONSOLIDER
- Those undergoing postdoctoral training (e.g. "Sara Borrell" or "Juan de la Cierva" contracts)

Additional national eligibility criteria for the proposal beyond the general criteria

- Only 3-year projects
- 1-2 research groups
- Only one proposal per partner is allowed
- Researchers with an ongoing project in 2018 in ERANET-LAC as partner cannot apply to the current call except if the researcher applies as coordinator and is not coordinating the ongoing project

NOTE:

There is no other incompatibility with AES 2017

Incompatibilities with other calls are subject to their respective specifications



National phase:

National applications will be required from Spanish applicants officially invited by ISCIII

Mandatory acknowledgement:

Any publication resulting from the granted projects must acknowledge "Award no. XX by ISCIII thorough AES 2017 and within the EU-LAC Health framework" even after the end of the project
