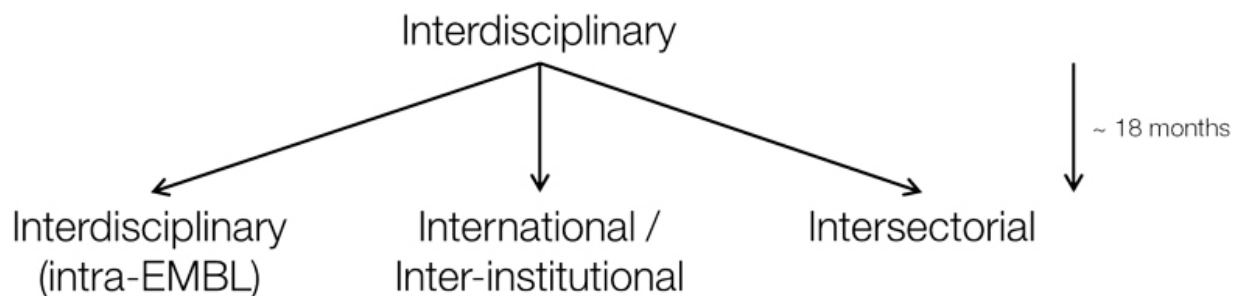


# Postdoctoral Programme

EMBL INTERDISCIPLINARY POSTDOCS (EIPOD)  
EI3POD PROGRAMME OVERVIEW

The EI<sub>3</sub>POD programme builds upon the original EIPOD programme which was designed to support interdisciplinary research projects involving two or more EMBL labs. The new scheme offers the additional possibility for fellows to take part in international/inter-institutional collaborations or an intersectorial experience while carrying out interdisciplinary research. The “I” in EI<sub>3</sub>POD refers to the **three career modules** supported by the programme:



## 1. Interdisciplinary EIPOD

- Interdisciplinary research project
- Projects involve one co-ordinating group leader and one partner lab both from EMBL faculty
- Classical EIPOD stream
- Aimed at an academic career path

## 2. International/inter-institutional EIPOD

- Interdisciplinary research project
- Projects involve EMBL supervisors (co-ordinator and partner) and one external academic partner

### **3. Intersectorial EIPOD**

- Interdisciplinary research project
- Designed to foster exposure to the applied/commercial side of science
- Projects involved EMBL supervisors (co-ordinator and partner) and either one industry partner or an active involvement of an EIPOD in IP generation, out-licensing and, if applicable, in the first steps towards a spin-off activity.

Industry partners are expected to come from, but not be limited to, members of the [EMBL Advanced Training Centre Corporate Partnership programme](#) and the [EMBL-EBI Industry programme](#). ### **Training & career development**

Fellows who take part in the EI<sub>3</sub>POD programme are supported by a career development service, including career counselling provided by a dedicated career advisor, and complete a series of [training activities](#).

### **Procedure**

All applicants apply with their own interdisciplinary research projects. They can choose one of the three available specialisation pathways already at the application stage or, if successful with the application, during the first 18 months of the fellowship.

Applicants are strongly encouraged to get directly in contact with their EMBL supervisor of choice while developing the project proposal and prior to submission.
