

## Become an Atlantic Fellow at GBHI

### APPLICATION PROCESS

All suitable candidates are encouraged to submit a full application, which are competitively reviewed by a selection committee from each partner organization. Applications require two letters of support to demonstrate regional commitment to an applicant's success, as well as a personal statement from the applicant that describes their passion and interest in the program. Short-listed applicants will be interviewed virtually by a GBHI representative, after which a final selection will be made. Up to 40 positions will be filled annually.

### AM I ELIGIBLE?

The Atlantic Fellows for Equity in Brain Health program at GBHI is an opportunity to elevate your dedication and contributions to brain health. Applicants should demonstrate a commitment to brain health and health care policy, as well as an ability to implement effective interventions in their home community and to become a regional leader in brain health.

GBHI welcomes applications from people living anywhere in the world and working in a variety of professions. Fellows are typically early and mid-career. At least one-half of

Fellows will come from outside the US and Ireland, with an initial emphasis on Latin America and the Mediterranean.

## WHAT ARE THE SELECTION CRITERIA?

Qualities sought in Atlantic Fellows at GBHI include:

- The ability to bring creative and relevant projects to fruition
- Long-term commitment to the values, mission, and goals of the program
- Ideas that could transform their local or global brain health environment
- Willingness and availability to complete 12 months of training; *(Please note that the standard duration is 12-months. Exceptions to be considered for 6-months is allowed with additional justification as to why 12 months is not possible.)*
- Fluency in English
- For physicians and scientists: successful completion of final graduate or post-graduate training (residency, fellowship, post-doctoral training, government internship, etc.)
