IBRO Travel Grants 2022

The IBRO Travel Grant program aims to foster neuroscience research by providing support to early-career Ph.D. students and post-doctoral fellows ≤ 40 years of age (+ time taken for parental leave) from diverse geographical and scientific areas who wish to participate in international neuroscience meetings and events taking place between **November 2021 – June 2022**.

Eligibility Requirements:

- At least one letter of reference is required in order to be considered for this grant. Two is ideal.
- Applicants from the US must be current Neuroscience Scholars Program (NSP) scholars or associates to be eligible to apply.

Grant award amount:

- Awards up to **1,800 Euros** will be given to those applying from Africa, Asia Pacific, Latin America, Pan Europe, and Canada.
- Awards up to **5,000 USD** will be given to those applying from the US (NSP fellows or associates).

Application deadline: September 3, 2021 (5:00 p.m. CET)
