

The Neuroendocrine Tumor Research Foundation (NETRF) is the leading non-profit organization supporting basic, translational and clinical NET research. Our mission is to accelerate scientific discovery that will help create new and more effective therapies for NETs.

Our grants range from \$100,000 to \$1.2 million for up to four years. We support scientists who conduct highly innovative research, whose work will help provide insight into the causes of NETs and/or lead to improved treatments for patients.

## Apply for NETRF research grants on [proposalCENTRAL](#)

The NETRF employs a 2-step grant process:

### 1. Letters of Intent (LOI)

Grant opportunities will be open in January **2022**. Interested applicants must submit a letter of intent (LOI) online via [proposalCENTRAL](#) that is due March **2022**. [Learn more about NETRF award criteria](#). LOIs sent directly to NETRF will not be considered.

### 2. Full Applications

A small number of investigators who submitted an LOI will be invited to submit a Full Proposal via [proposalCENTRAL](#). Both the LOI and Full Proposal are reviewed by NETRF's [Board of Scientific Advisors](#) and external expert reviewers. The most meritorious applications are recommended to NETRF's [Board of Directors](#) for funding.

## Awards

NETRF will notify applicants of grant decisions in late 2022 and offer feedback to those applicants whose grants are not funded. Applicants whose projects are approved for funding receive an award letter outlining the next steps
